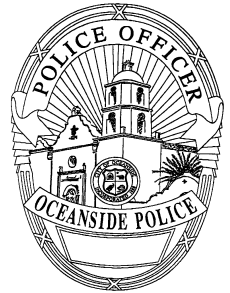

THREE SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN A STOLEN VEHICLE **AFTER A SHORT PURSUIT**

At 7:30 a.m. today two men and one woman were arrested on Lake Blvd. after they fled on foot from a stolen vehicle that was being pursued by police. The suspects were booked into the Vista Detention Facility. There were no injuries.

At approximately 7:20 a.m. Oceanside Police received a Lojack auto theft alert in the area of Lake Blvd and Emerald Drive indicating a stolen vehicle was being driven in the area. Officers located the vehicle (2002 Cadillac Escalade) traveling north on Sunset Drive at Emerald. Officers pursued the vehicle for several minutes and the driver stopped the car in the area of Lake Blvd east of Skyhaven. Three of the four occupants were detained as they fled from the car on foot. The fourth occupant has not been located. The occupants were identified as 21-year-old San Marcos resident Julienne Fernandez and Oceanside residents' 22-year-old Bradlee Davis and 21-year-old James Holder. All were booked in the VDF for possession of stolen property, being under the influence of a controlled substance and conspiracy. The driver, Davis, was also charged with felony evading and auto theft.

The car had been reported stolen (unoccupied) from Carlsbad approximately one hour before it was located by Police; the owner of the car was visiting from Arizona. Police recovered property from the car that was taken during a string of car burglaries that occurred overnight in San Clemente, Carlsbad and Vista after the car was stolen.
