POLICE ANNOUNCE TRAFFIC SATURATION RESULTS

The Oceanside Police Department conducted a multi-agency traffic saturation detail today, July 22, 2009.

Members of allied law enforcement agencies converged on the City of Oceanside today to reinforce the rules of the road. Twenty-three officers from seven allied agencies from around the county issued 203 citations in a three and one half hour time frame, and impounded 29 vehicles. The vehicles were impounded due to the fact the drivers had no license or were operating the vehicle on a suspended or revoked driver's license.

Each month, members of the city's traffic units rotate their efforts in a different local jurisdiction to assist with problem areas and to enforce the overall rules of the road.

The City of Oceanside currently has 8 dedicated motorcycle officers whose primary duties are to enforce the rules of the road. To increase that number several times a year with the assistance of allied agencies reaches all areas of the city during peak traffic hours.

It continues to be the goal of the Police Department to provide the highest level of service to the community. Your safety is our business.
