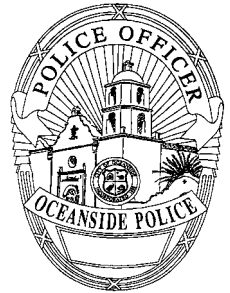

OCEANSIDE POLICE INVESTIGATE DEATH OF A WOMAN FOUND IN HER CAR AFTER BEING REPORTED MISSING

A woman was found dead in her car today after being reported missing by her live-in boyfriend. The circumstances surrounding the case are such that Police have yet to make a determination as to whether the case is a homicide or a suicide.

The 38-year-old woman was reported missing by her boyfriend today at approximately 11:21 a.m. on July 26, 2010. After reporting her missing, the boyfriend searched the surrounding neighborhoods for her car. He located the car at approximately 2:00 p.m. and called police. The woman was subsequently found deceased in the trunk of the vehicle. Based on the initial findings, it is plausible the girl entered the trunk herself. No further details of the case are being released at this time, pending the findings from the Coroner's Office as to cause of death.
