OCEANSIDE POLICE ARREST TWO HOMICIDE SUSPECTS

The Oceanside Police Communications center was called on Sunday August 23, 2009 at approximately 6:00pm in regards to a man down inside a business in the 900 block of South Coast Highway in Oceanside.

The reporting parties contacted police via telephone and advised of a possible murder victim inside the Auto Center located at 920 South Coast Highway in Oceanside. Officers responded to the scene and found 23 year old Charles Evan Williams, the owner of the business deceased. Williams is a Carlsbad resident. The initial investigation as to the cause of the death is from stab wounds. The exact cause of death will be determined by an autopsy.

Witness information lead Oceanside Police to an apartment in the 700 block of Fallbrook Street in Fallbrook where two suspects were arrested for the homicide. Suspect statements and physical evidence have linked the suspects to the crime.

The first suspect is 19 year old Xavier Akeam Adams, a Marine stationed aboard Camp Pendleton.

The second suspect is 20 year old Raphael Roshod Davis Ramey, also a Marine stationed aboard Camp Pendleton. Both suspects are originally from Texas.

The investigation and interviews of the suspects are on-going at this time. Detectives are working on the exact motive as to the reason for the crime.

Both suspects will be booked into the Sheriff's Detention Facility in Vista for Homicide and Conspiracy charges.
